SAAAACF 2023 IMPACT



BAIL - provides bail and release for persons with low level offenses that cannot afford bail and would suffer from the adverse effects associated with confinement.



JUVENILE JUSTICE JEOPARDY PROGRAM - engages youth in important conversations about the juvenile justice system, and the potential consequences of their actions.



COMMUNITY BASKETBALL PROGRAM - take youth from marginalized communities and work with them to produce future leaders.
